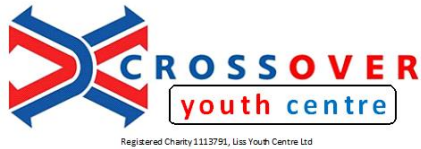

## COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR CROSSOVER

Crossover Youth Centre has been operating since 2005 providing a valuable facility for the young people of this community and surrounding area. We are very grateful for support in the form of local government grants and donations from other charitable bodies, however as local council budgets are under pressure we have seen a drop in our grants and we expect this to continue into the future, with potentially **no funding available** from Hampshire County Council from April 2020.

This is where you can help us; please consider making a regular contribution and completing the Banker's Order overleaf. Regular income helps us to plan ahead and structure future provision for our young people. *If you are an existing donor, we really would like to thank you, as we couldn't do it without you!*

**We do not charge young people to access Crossover and the activities we provide as we want everything to be accessible to all.**

- Crossover currently opens for five sessions a week for young people and we also run a tennis session at Newman Collard. We would love to open for more sessions and make the most of our facilities. *(We currently have no sessions Mon & Fri after school, or Thurs & Fri evenings – but we could make this happen!)*
- We provide a cheaply priced cafe, table tennis, pool, table football, board games, computers, arts & crafts, musical instruments, outdoor activities, occasional trips and the opportunity to meet and make good friends.
- We have an in-house trained counsellor who offers free one-to-one sessions, dealing with a range of issues including low self-esteem, anxiety, depression and other challenges faced by young people.
- We are hoping to extend our outreach work in the village where youth workers engage groups of young people who may be feeling disaffected and in need of extra support. Anti-social behaviour has reduced in the village since Crossover opened and we continue to work on this.

If you are unable to support us financially, you can support us by giving some of your time as a volunteer, even if only 2 hours per month. We employ qualified youth workers but also require a team of volunteers to assist them in running sessions. Volunteers as well as youth workers build valuable relationships with young people, with long lasting positive effects. The volunteers would have access to training as required. If you would like to become involved, please come in and have a chat.
